Kentucky Wine & Vine Fest

Frankfort, Kentucky, February 3, 2006 – The Kentucky Tourism Council has selected the Kentucky Wine & Vine Fest as one of the Commonwealth's spring "Top Ten" events.

A mix of Haute cuisine, a dash of homegrown and a thorough splash of the unexpected define this festival in its 3rd year. That mix of being "not exactly" what you'd expect from a gathering devoted to wine is just what makes the event one of the most charming festivals in the South. With at least 13 vineyards in Jessamine County, downtown Nicholasville is the sight for this unique festival celebrating the heritage of American Viticulture on May 13.

A panel of impartial judges selects the Kentucky Tourism Council "Top Ten" Events for each season. Criteria for selection include popularity of the event, its impact on the local tourism economy as well as cultural and historical significance.
